




COGNITION




CONCUSSION AND SCHOOLS?

THE HEAD AND SPINAL CORD INJURY REGISTRY

- Established to link individuals with TBI and SCI to services
- Hospital Data received from Public Health monthly-ICD 10 codes
- Initial contact made
- Individuals and families respond , request information/services
- Requests are tracked
- Report on incidence and response to State Head Injury Task Force, Trust Fund and Legislators

PASSAGES: CRS CHILDREN/YOUTH WITH TBI

<u>Purpose:</u> To assist children and youth in transitioning from hospital to home and community.

Services: Information & referral Care coordination Treatment Transportation Community Education Supplemental Support Transition

INTERACTIVE COMMUNITY-BASED MODEL: ADULTS WITH TBI

<u>Purpose:</u> To enable consumers to improve their readiness for services leading to employment.

Services: Case Management Neuropsychological Evaluation Other Evaluations/Assessments Counseling Cognitive Remediation Education/Training – consumers, families, providers Community Re-entry Transportation Consult: Vocational Rehab, Children's Rehab, Independent Living, other staff

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICE

<u>Purpose:</u> To assist with achieving maximum potential through employment opportunities.

Services: Evaluations/Assessments including neuropsychological testing Vocational guidance & counseling Individualized Plan for Employment Training/education Job readiness Employment assistance Job coaching


